### **Diving Information for Scientists**

#### **Scientific divers need to submit:**

- Scuba waiver
- Scuba regulations form (pay attention to equipment checklist)
- Diver registration form
- AAUS letter of reciprocity **or** all of the following:
  - Medical – 6 pages (full approval, completed and signed)
  - Photocopy of certification card- front and back
  - Photocopies of logged dives- need to have done 12 dives in the last 12 months (if not will have to make own arrangements to do some additional diving before being cleared for science diving)
  - Verification that scuba gear has been serviced in the last 12 months
  - Photocopy of current CPR/First Aid training\*\*
  - Photocopy of current O2 Provider training\*\*

\*\*These may be done through BBSR on a minimum number basis. Contact the DSO for info.

Forms will be collected upon arrival. Forms must be submitted and complete in order to be able to dive. There will be NO exceptions.

There will be a check-out dive for all divers before field trips commence

Dive lockers are available to store your equipment
